GUIDELINES

The **OUTSTANDING CITIZEN AWARD** is designed to recognize an individual – not employed by a public school – who has made a significant contribution to public education, during the previous calendar year, and as exemplified by one or a combination of the following:

- 1. Improving student achievement or curriculum
- 2. Contributing to the advancement of the profession
- 3. Promoting public education and/or school safety

Nominations for the award should be made in a letter format stating the name of the person and the reasons for the nomination.

Documentation supporting the nomination may include, but not limited to, photographs, news clippings, video clips, newsletters, or letters of recommendation.

Submission of the form, letter and supporting documentation MUST be received at the AEA Headquarters in Little Rock by **5:00pm on the first Friday of September at 5:00pm**.
